## Pentecost Sunday – 04 June 2017

Next weekend, June 10-11, will be a missionary visit by Father Thomas Otanga for Kenya Mission Appeals 2017. This will be a second collection that weekend.

### Kenya Mission Appeals 2017

The mission in Kenya began in 1992. The appeal collection is used to help our 40+ Discalced Carmelite Missionaries (Priests and Brothers) share the good news of Jesus Christ through prayer, presence and projects of love. These “Contemplatives in Action” work to alleviate the poverty of the people who come to us for assistance with basic needs- food, clothing, and (limited) medical assistance. These missionaries are chaplains, retreat directors, catechists and hospital volunteers. Currently, we have open and minister at five new sites (3 parishes, two retreat centers with more than fourteen outstations and one formation house) in Kenya.

The order of Discalced Carmelite Friars was founded by St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross, in the 16th Century. These two great saints are known for their writing on spirituality. Both have been honored by the church with the title “doctor of the church”. Another distinguished member of the order of the Discalced Carmelite is St. Therese of Lisieux, also known as “The Little Flower”. She, too, received the honor of “doctor of the church” for her writings on spirituality. All her life, St. Therese desired to go to the foreign missions. Due to poor health, she was unable.

The Discalced Carmelite Friars are present in missions around the world. The Appeal in your parish will be for the support of our mission in Kenya, Africa. Although, Kenya is considered to be one of the more advanced and stable of the African nations, large numbers of it’s population suffer greatly from poverty, disease and lack of basic necessities of life. This is aggravated by corruption in government. Were it not for the help of the many missionary congregation in Kenya, there would be very little hope for the many who suffer. Kenyans are a gentle and peace-loving people. Their deeply religious nature finds expression in exuberant liturgies abounding in song, dance and colorful vestments and attire.

The primary work of the Discalced Carmelite Friars in Nairobi, the capital of Kenya, consists in educating native African Friars, from several English-speaking countries in East Africa, for the priesthood. In addition, our missionaries operate parishes, outstations and retreat facilities for the diocesan clergy, religious congregations, and laity. Finally, we offer whatever assistance we can to the poor who knock on our church door each day.

Your gift, great or small, will be deeply appreciated and will allow our missionaries in this far away land to fulfill the baptismal commitment that we all share- to bring the good news to all corners of the earth. In addition, we ask that you pray daily for our mission and missionaries everywhere.
