* SNS currently has open registration this summer so parents may register their children entering Grades K-8 at the church office during regular office hours (Mon. 8:30-2:00, Wed. & Thurs., 8:30-3:00). The Support Club sign up book will also be available to sign up for fundraisers AFTER registration has been completed.

* St. Norbert School will be holding registration for Grades K-8 on Tuesday, July 11 from 6-8pm. Parents of children attending Children's House of Montessori may drop off their packet given to them at the end of this past school year. Prospective Children's House families may also pick up packets this evening. When registering your child, please remember to bring all mandatory documents. If you have questions regarding required documents or cannot make the evening session, please contact the church office at 576-2628 or stnorbertschool@snsnwolves.com. All transfer students will be eligible for two years of half price tuition. If you are interested learning more about SNS academic or extracurricular activities, email stnorbertschool@snsnwolves.com. **Birth Certificate** - All students entering Kindergarten or an Illinois school for the first time, must produce an original Birth certificate at the time of registration. A copy will be made by school staff and the original will be returned to the guardian. **Dental Screening** - Grades K, 2 & 6. Forms are available at your dental office. If your child has been seen recently, contact your dentist and have them fax the form to 576-8074. (Before May 15 of the school year, each child in kindergarten and the second and sixth grades shall present to the school proof of having been examined by a dentist in accordance with Section 27-8.1(1.5) of the School Code.) **Vision Screening** - Grade K or a student entering an Illinois School for the first time. **Physical Exam** - Grades K, 6 or ANY student that is participating in a school sponsored sport. **Immunizations** - Illinois Department of Public Health amended the Child Health Examination Code Part 665 to require students in the sixth through twelfth grades to show proof of recent pertussis vaccination. The revised rule requires that all students entering, advancing, or transferring into grades 6-12 show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) regardless of the interval since the last DTaP, DT or Td dose. Introduced in 2015, all students entering into the 6-12 grades must also show proof of meningococcal vaccine with the first dose at grade 6 and second by the entering of grade 12. Please check with your pediatrician to ensure that all immunizations are up to date.
