

Vision Screening -Grade K or a student entering an Illinois School for the first time. Physical Exam - Grades K, 6 or ANY student that is participating in a school sponsored sport. Immunizations - Illinois Department of Public Health amended the Child Health Examination Code Part 665
- proof of recent pertussis vaccination. The revised rule requires that all students entering, advancing, or transferring into grades 6-12 show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) regardless of the interval since the last DTaP, DT or Td dose. Introduced in 2015, all students entering into the 6-12 grades must also show proof of meningococcal vaccine with the first dose at grade 6 and second by the entering of grade 12. Please check with your pediatrician to ensure that all immunizations are up to date.
