26th Sunday in Ordinary Time In today's Gospel, Jesus suggests that there are two types of "followers": the first is the one who says he will follow the law of the LORD, but he does not follow through; the second one says he does not wish to follow the law of the LORD, but changes his mind and does so. Jesus' question is a difficult one for us today. Stewardship is obviously the right way of life, but it is sometimes a difficult one. Many people find that, while they intend to live the stewardship way of life, they don't ever get around to it. The good news is that it is not too late! Psalm 25 says, "...teach me your paths, guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my savior." When we know the right path, and recognize we are not on it, we must be diligent to correct our behavior.
