28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Many are invited, but few are chosen." In this parable, Jesus refers to the Israelites -- the chosen people -- who openly rejected Jesus as the Messiah. This closing verse is interesting, because we often think that being invited is really the same as being chosen. Why wouldn't you choose those whom you had also invited? Perhaps because they have openly rejected the invitation. Sadly, when it comes to the current day steward, we are all invited to participate, but many of us are rejecting the invitation -- some openly and some secretly and some unintentionally. We let busyness and the things of this world interfere with our invitation; therefore, it isn't that God didn't choose us ... it is more like we haven't chosen HIM. Who / What are YOU following?

Sister Lucia of Fatima Speaks on the Rosary: "The Most Holy Virgin in these last times in which we live has given a new efficacy to the recitation of the Rosary to such an extent that there is no problem, no matter how difficult it is, whether temporal or above all, spiritual, in the personal life of each one of us, of our families, of the families of the world, or of the religious communities, or even of the life of peoples and nations, that cannot be solved by the Rosary. There is no problem I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot resolve by the prayer of the Holy Rosary."
