OCTOBER 22, 2017 - "WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?"

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time Isaiah 45:6 "I am the LORD, there is no other." In today's Gospel, the Pharisees try to trap Jesus by asking if it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar. They are hoping to snare Him using false flattery and either the Jewish law or the political law of the day. Of course, Jesus doesn't fall into the trap. His response: "Then repay to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's." The steward realizes that everything belongs to God, the creator of all things. Jesus knows this, too. However, He also knows that God has little use for tax dollars...what HE wants from us -- our whole-hearted love -- is much more valuable. His response is aimed at the commandment against idolatry, and is a call to follow God. In fact, His response sounds very much like our Stewardship Theme, "Who are you following?"

Sister Lucia of Fatima Speaks on the Rosary: "The Most Holy Virgin in these last times in which we live has given a new efficacy to the recitation of the Rosary to such an extent that there is no problem, no matter how difficult it is, whether temporal or above all, spiritual, in the personal life of each one of us, of our families, of the families of the world, or of the religious communities, or even of the life of peoples and nations, that cannot be solved by the Rosary. There is no problem I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot resolve by the prayer of the Holy Rosary." "With the Holy Rosary, we will save ourselves, we will sanctify ourselves, we will console Our Lord and obtain the salvation of many souls."

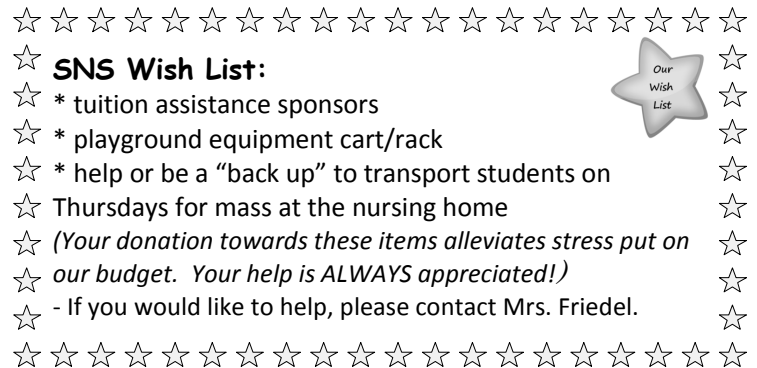
School News
