Most Holy Trinity – 27 May 2018

Making connections. We step away from reading the Gospel of Mark today to hear the ending scene from Matthew. It makes the connection to Matthew 25 heard last November on Christ the King. The scene, then, was the great divide of sheep and goats – the naming of the Works of Mercy. The scene today is both the ending of Jesus' earthly ministry and the beginning of the Church's. This ministry is (1) to go to all nations and peoples; (2) to baptize; (3) to train and form new followers, new disciples. They were told then as we are assured today: Jesus is present with us always – along with Father and Spirit. - Where and when do I see the presence of God in the world? Where and when do I feel the saving presence of Christ? Where and when do I know the Spirit is taking control?

May 27, 2018 - "WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?" The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity As followers of Jesus Christ, we should find ourselves particularly moved by today's readings. In St. Paul's letter to the Romans, he says we have received a spirit of adoption that makes of joint heirs with Christ our brother. In Matthew's gospel, we receive The Great Commissioning -- we are sent into the world to continue the work begun by Jesus. In our stewarding of the gifts given to us through the Holy Spirit, we too are given the opportunity to proclaim the Gospel. One of the greatest gift we have been given to steward, is the understanding that God is Three: three persons and one nature. We didn't know this before Jesus revealed it. What difference does it make? God is a community of persons. Sharing of our gifts cannot happen outside of community. God models relationships for us. Now we must share this gift of who God is with others. How do we start? By telling others about Jesus, for Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Light. Begin stewarding the gift of Jesus!

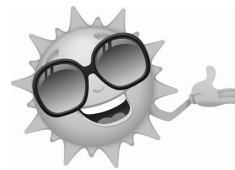

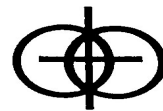
