Sunday in Ordinary Time The reading from Mark's Gospel reveals a less-than-inspiring theme of rejection. Not even the Son of God was immune to rejection -- He received it from the Jews, from religious and political leaders, from some of His followers, and as we see today, from His own family. But a second look at today's Gospel also reveals a new definition of love and what it means to be family. In Mark 3:34-35, Jesus says, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." As followers of Jesus Christ, we are counted among His brothers and sisters -- His family. The heart of a steward casts off rejection and seeks the will of God by reaching out to others in love and in service.

Prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to your will. Grant, Good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

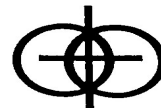
