Letter from the Bishop regarding this weekend's second collection for Peter's Pence...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon our diocese will take the Peter's Pence Collection (PPC). This global collection supports the Holy Father as he reaches out in mercy and charity to people who are suffering. Your generosity will help Pope Francis ease the suffering of some of the most marginalized throughout the world and show them the tender love of God.

Pope Francis challenges us to look at those around us with the eyes of mercy. He says, "We encounter so many weary and oppressed people today ... And how is our heart? Is it merciful? And our way of thinking and acting, is it inclusive?" (Jubilee Audience, Nov. 12, 2016). I invite you to reflect on how you feel moved to answer the call to mercy.

In Iraq, many people still live a nightmare of war and violence. This has left many displaced, including young people in the midst of their studies. Without an educated population, it will be difficult for the country to gain stability. With this help, the students can complete their university education and move forward with the hope of rebuilding their country.

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 01 July 2018

In the pressing crowd. God is *not* far off! God acts in the pressing crowd, the commotion of life. God rescues us at birth and in the new baptismal birth, when afflicted, and when near death. Jesus said to Jairus and says to us today: Do not be afraid; just have faith. - What do I fear? How can I be unafraid this week? Who can help me? How will staying in touch with Jesus make all the difference?

July 1, 2018 - "WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?" Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Our Gospel today speaks to the dire need for great faith. It is not uncommon for man to grow complacent in his faith, and this complacency can actually diminish his faith. Imagine you are part of the crowd in today's gospel. How many dozens of people must have touched or bumped into Jesus as He was making His way through the crowd?! Most of those people didn't recognize that they encountered Christ Himself, and they went about their business. But the hemorrhaging woman knew who He was and she reached out in faith, knowing that simply touching His garment would save her life. We would like to think that we live a life of faith such as hers, but how often have we brushed against Jesus...in Mass, or in our neighbor on the street, or in our own hurried prayers...only to walk away unchanged because of our lack of faith? Your baptism calls you into deep relationship with Jesus, and this relationship demands great faith. In our Stewardship, let us not "accidentally" encounter Jesus, but live in a way that we deliberately do so!
