August 26, 2018 - "Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples" Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time *Jos 24: 1-2A, 15-17, 18B / Eph 5: 21-32 / Jn 6: 60-69* A life lived fully for Jesus Christ is a challenging one. It means constantly saying "no" to the distractions from the world, even those that might seem fairly harmless. For this reason, many people choose to walk away from discipleship. We see this in today's Gospel reading. In John 6: 66-67, we hear that "many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him." At this, Jesus asked the Twelve if they would also like to leave. Herein lies the lesson: discipleship is a free choice. We worship a God who loves freely and wants us to do so in return...freely. Our stewardship is a gift of self and is not meant to be offered out of obligation. Obligatory giving does not bring about joy...rather, it creates resentment. In just a few weeks, we will begin the Stewardship Renewal process. This weekend allows the opportunity to begin thinking and praying about ways we can give back to God freely and share in the joy that comes from serving Him and His people.

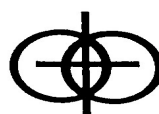

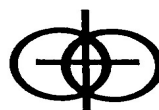
