Kick-Off of the Stewardship Season

Over the next few weeks we will be celebrating and highlighting the many blessings our parishes have received. We are launching the *Season for Stewardship*. We often hear that stewardship is a response to being a disciple. But in a deeper context, what are we asking? What is stewardship? How do we discern if we are living a stewardship way of life? We can prayerfully discern our response to this question by:


- Reflecting on how often we pray or how often we attend Sunday Mass or daily Mass
- Renewing our commitment to serve as disciples by spending time in service to others
- Responding gratefully to the gifts we have received, acknowledging that all we have is a gift from God that we are to share with others

Our theme for this *Season of Stewardship* is "All things are possible for God" from today's Gospel of Mark. The story of the rich man and Jesus tells us much about a stewardship way of life. If we are living out of gratitude, we are willing to not just give the minimum, but to give up everything. We are *detached* from material goods, in order to *attach* ourselves to God. Everything we have is a gift from God and we are called to share those gifts with genuine gratitude and joy, not as a burden. Generosity starts with God's love. His love for each of us leads us to be joyful givers!

Stewardship is not asking for money or a fundraiser. It is a time when we can prayerfully discern our commitment to participate, be holy, put God first, serve others, give more of ourselves. After Mass, please pick up a Stewardship Booklet from one of the ushers. I ask you for two minutes a day over the next four weeks to use this booklet to guide you in reflection. Additionally, each time we participate in the offertory, consider this thought: "Who can I pray for this week, how can I serve, and how much can I give." I am amazed by the generosity of our community and hope you will consider joining us.
