*all things are possible for God!*

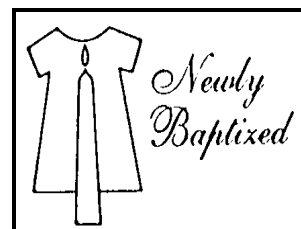
