Please Be Generous Next Weekend

On behalf of Archbishop Paul K. Bakyenga of Mbarara, Uganda, thank you for allowing Fr. Ignitius "Iggy" Nimwesiga to speak on behalf of the Archdiocese of Mbarara.

The Archdiocese of Mbarara was created in 1999 in Southwestern Uganda in East Africa. It has a population of about 2,300,000 people with about 1,150,000 being Catholics. The Archdiocese has 175 priests of whom 160 are indigenous. It has 56 parishes and 150 Missions. 90% of the population served by the Archdiocese live in rural places.

Challenges:

- * To provide services in the very rural parts of the Archdiocese so as to stand strong against Islamic Fundamentalism and other Pentecostal Churches
- * To counteract high levels of poverty. Annual per capita income is equivalent to US \$200.00.
- * To provide safe water in rural areas.
- * to support the eradication of controllable and curable diseases

The weekend of July 27/28, the 2nd collection will go to this Archdiocese.
