Matrimony--Please contact the office at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date. One person in the couple must be a registered parishioner and a practicing Catholic.

Prior to your child's birth, both parents must register for our Baptism Program, and attend before the baptism. These are held at the Hardin office quarterly, with the next one March 6 at 7 PM.

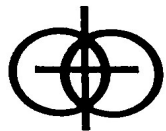
South County Library will have evening hours starting Tuesday, February 4th. The library will be open from 4 - 7 PM on Tuesday evenings.

Greetings friends of St. Norbert School,
