Matrimony--Please contact the office at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date. One person in the couple must be a registered parishioner and a practicing Catholic.

Prior to your child's birth, both parents must register for our Baptism Program, and attend before the baptism. These are held at the Hardin office quarterly, with the next one June 5 at 7 PM.

The openings will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

Confirmation/First Eucharist—Bishop Paprocki has delegated to pastors the faculty to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to children who were scheduled to have been confirmed by him this year, giving priority to those children who recently reached the age of reason, that is, those in about third grade, who were to have been fully initiated into the Church with the reception of Confirmation and First Eucharist this past Spring. The option for receiving Confirmation by the bishop remains the prerogative of the parents and is available to all; however, there is no information yet as to the timeliness of this possibility. Letters have been sent to families of the confirmandi outlining the options. We ask for patience and prayers as Fr. Roberts begins, mid-June to utilize weekday and weekend Masses through early July to administer the sacraments.
