We are reopening Masses this weekend! As you are noticing, appointments are not necessary. We are allowed 25% of our capacity at this time—63 persons at St. Norbert and 80 at St. Anselm. We made the difficult decision to keep Masses at this time in Kampsville, rather than Michael, so that more individuals may attend. Please follow the posted directions, along with those from our ushers, so that we can stay safe while enjoying our beautiful liturgy. If you have questions or concerns at any time, please call our offices.

Confirmation/First Eucharist—Bishop Paprocki has delegated to pastors the faculty to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to children who were scheduled to have been confirmed by him this year, giving priority to those children who recently reached the age of reason. The option for receiving Confirmation by the bishop remains the prerogative of the parents and is available to all; however, there is no information yet as to the timeliness of this possibility. Letters have been sent to families of the confirmandi outlining the options.

Next weekend, June 13/14, we welcome Rev. George Knab, O.M.I.—a preacher for Unbound—Rev. Knab is a priest of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate. In 2013 he moved to Belleville, IL, near the National Shrine of Our Lady of Snows. When he's not traveling and preaching, he conducts a Monday morning Bible study at the St. Vincent de Paul soup kitchen in East St. Louis, IL. In 2016 he was designated as a Missionary of Mercy by Pope Francis. Fr. Knab is the author of a booklet of bedside Eucharistic devotions first published as *Communion Services* by the Liturgical Press and then released by Jeremiah Press as *Bread of Faith*. Unbound is a sponsorship organization founded in 1981 and serves more than 300,000 children, youth, elderly persons, and their families living in poverty in economically developing countries.
