## Are You a Disciple?

In her new book, *Start With Jesus*, Julianne Stanz lists what she calls the 10 D's of discipleship. We are exploring these over the course of a few weeks. Here are 5 & 6:

5. **Dwelling in the Word.** "The Word of God holds the power to form and transform us. God speaks to us in his Word. Therefore, a disciple cannot grow and be nourished apart from the Word of God. Dwelling in the Word of God is absolutely essential for growth in the Christian life."
6. **Dependence of the Holy Spirit.** "All the good that we do in life depends on the action or animation of the Holy Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit who shines through us and awakens in us the desire to follow Jesus and to grow in holiness. We must become more dependent on listening to the promptings and "nudgings" of the Holy Spirit."

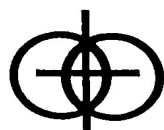
