### Are You a Disciple?

In her new book, *Start With Jesus*, Julianne Stanz lists what she calls the 10 D's of discipleship. We are exploring these over the course of a few weeks. Here are 7 & 8:

- 7. **Denial.** "Saying yes to God means saying no to those habits, beliefs, and practices that pull us away from him. Denial of self so that we can carry the cross helps us develop reliance on God and resilience for the journey ahead. Jesus reminds us that 'if any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me' (Mark 8:34)."
- 8. **Dedication.** "Being a friend and follower of Jesus involves daily dedication to living a virtuous and moral life. Dedication involves sacrificing our time and self to give to others and to sanctify the world."

#### ReLit Mini-Workshop II


The follow up to our January ReLit workshop is finally being held!
