Are You a Disciple?

In her new book, *Start With Jesus*, Julianne Stanz lists what she calls the 10 D's of discipleship. We have been exploring these over the last few weeks. Here are the final two, 9 & 10:

- 9. **Deliberation.** "Intentionality is necessary for the disciple. Like all practices, growth in discipleship is the result of small daily actions that help us conform ourselves even more to Christ. This is not happenstance but, rather, takes time and effort to plan and center our lives around our relationship with Christ. In the words of John, 'he must increase, but I must decrease' (John 3:30)"
- 10. **Doing.** "Discipleship is not a program but a process, a way of life. The entire discipleship process is an apprenticeship in faith, in the living out of the Christian life. We must move from being hearers of the Word to 'doers' of the word. Nourished by his very body and blood, Jesus urges us to 'do this in remembrance of me' (Luke 22:19)."
