On Tuesday evening, prizes will be offered for the five best sweet potatoes, on Wednesday evening, for the ten best apples, any variety and on Thursday evening, for the five best ears of corn. First, second and third prizes will be given for these articles. Also on Thursday evening, the grand raffle will take place. Do not forget that the number of winning tickets must be in the hall. If you cannot be there in person, let someone else take care of your ticket for you. All are cordially invited.*
