Visiting Priest This Weekend & 2nd Collection—Fr. José Nieto was ordained a priest on May 17, 2014, for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. He is from a small town on the Caribbean Coast of Colombia. He grew up in Colombia, and after finishing his degree in civil engineering he joined the Community of Saint Paul and moved to Dominican Republic in 2004.

While in the Dominican Republic, he lived and worked in *La Sagrada Familia* Parish, which is in the southwest corner of the country, close to the border with Haiti. José worked as the associate pastor at Saint William and Saint John Neumann parishes in Waukesha, Wisconsin. By the request of his Archbishop Fr. José moved to Washington DC in 2018 to complete further studies in Scripture at Catholic University of America.
