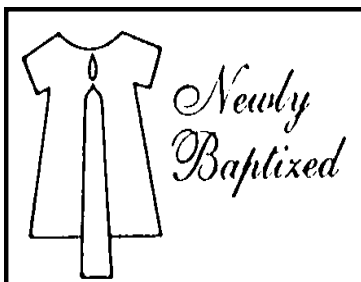

 A trait of home mission dioceses is that many have a small Catholic population dispersed over a vast territory.
