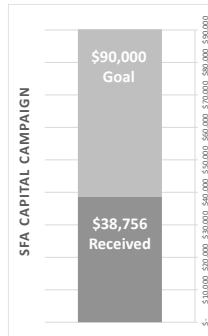
There will be a second collection this weekend, September 17-18, for the Church in Africa.


