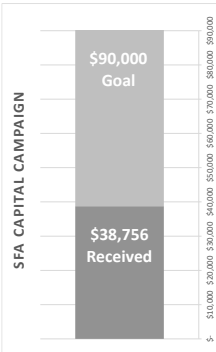
### No 5pm Mass this Sunday, September 25.
