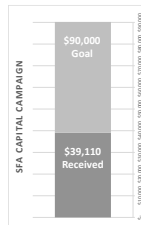
St. Mary Cemetery: Thanks to Jeanette Droege for her effort in receiving a \$500 gift for St. Mary's Cemetery from REA Co-op.


The Rally is always held on a Saturday closest to the October 13 date of the Miracle of the Sun which occurred at Fatima, Portugal on October 13, 1917.
