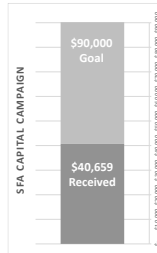
St. Mary's Altar Society will meet on Friday, November 4 at 7pm at the church hall. Plans for the November 30 outing will be discussed.

The Eucharist in Scripture

Video series by DR. Scott Hahn

Each Wednesday, October 26—November 30
6:00-7:15pm at SFA parish office
(coincides with PSR times)

Come join us on this six-session bible study course which gives great insight to the connection between the Old and New Testaments regarding the establishment of the Eucharist by Jesus.

Each half hour video will be followed by questions, discussion and prayer. The course is free of charge including workbooks adorned with beautiful religious art.

No need to register and no requirement to attend all six sessions, although attendance for the complete course would be most beneficial.

Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time – 30 October 2022 Wisdom 11:22–12:2. Psalm 145:1-2, 8-9, 10-11, 13, 14. 2 Thessalonians 1:11–2:2. Luke 19:1-10.

Whom Does Jesus Seek? The short of stature Zacchaeus runs ahead, climbs a tree, and seeks Jesus as he passes by. But Jesus stops, seeks Zacchaeus out, and invites himself to dinner. This story, as is all of the gospel, is about us, too. In our seeking Jesus, we discover he has been seeking us. All. The. Time. Why does Jesus want to stay with me? How does his invitation to stay with me urge me to change some behaviors? How does all of this help me to be more generous? What mercy work will I do this week?

All Saints, Solemnity – Tuesday, 01 November 2022

Revelation 7:2-4, 9-14. Psalm 24:1-2, 3-4, 5-6.

1 John 3:1-3. Matthew 5:1-12a.

Do We Stand Among the Saints? Sainthood, holy behavior is described in the gospel beatitudes today. The Second Letter of Saint John tells us, “we are God’s holy children now.” We do not have to wait to be dead to be holy. Pope Francis wrote to us on holiness – Apostolic Exhortation *Gaudete et Exsultate* on the Call to Holiness in Today’s World. He urges us to be holy ourselves (it is possible) and to look for the saint next door (they do exist). What holiness will I seek out in those I see today?
