**Blessed Trinity Finance Council** will meet on Tuesday, November 22, at 7pm at Meppen Hall.

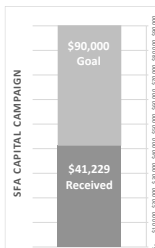
**Baptism Class:** The next baptism class will be on Friday, December 2 at 6:30pm in the SFA parish office.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
With a population of over 1.1 million inhabitants, the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois has tens of thousands of people within our diocese living below the poverty line. These women, men and children are hungry, homeless, and hurting. If you have contributed in the past, consider increasing your gift by a few dollars. All funds collected are distributed to organizations within our diocesan boundaries that provide help and hope to the poor in accord with Catholic teaching. Last year, 21 organizations were offered grants. It is my hope that this year's collection will increase so that we can meet the needs of even more people living in poverty. May God bless you and reward you with peace, joy, and hope.
