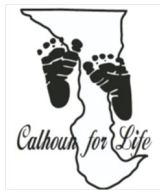

Calhoun For Life Quarter Auction will be on Saturday, April 1, 2023 at the KC Hall in Hardin.

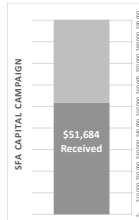
