St. Francis of Assisi Finance Council meeting is changing to May 30 at 7pm this month. Pastoral Council will not meet.

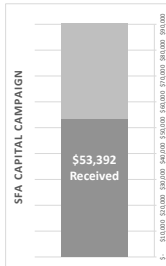

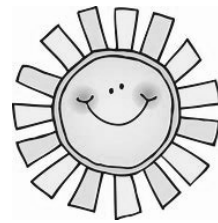
