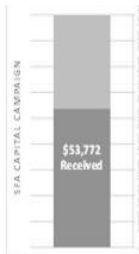

Thank you to the Cathy Miller Rice Family for the Memorial Donation to St. Norbert School. It is very much appreciated!

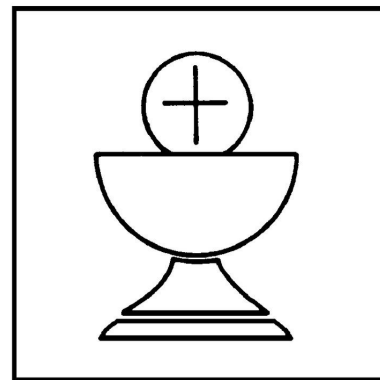

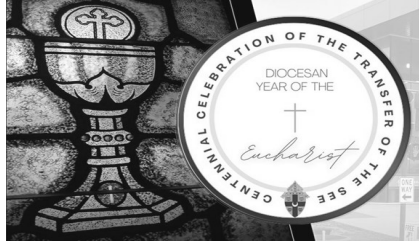
