Mercy—The Message of Easter

Happy Easter!

Did you know that, as Catholics, we celebrate the Solemnity of Easter not only on Easter Sunday, but for eight days? We call these days the Octave of Easter, and the last day of this Octave is Divine Mercy Sunday. And did you know that Jesus offers extraordinary graces to souls specifically on this last day of the Octave? He told St. Faustina:



On that day, [Divine Mercy Sunday] the very depths of My tender mercy are opened. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, though its sins be as scarlet. (Diary, 699)

This truly is a triumph of God's mercy and love! Why? Because when we normally go to Confession, our sins are forgiven and the eternal punishment due to sin (i.e., hell) is removed, but the temporal punishment due to sin (Purgatory) may still remain. However, Our Lord offers us the remission of sins and of all punishment due to sin on the Octave of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday.

How do we obtain this grace?

- By making a valid Confession before or on the day of the Feast.
- By receiving Holy Communion on the day of the Feast in a state of grace (no mortal sin)** and with the intention of obtaining the promised grace.

The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated in every Catholic Church throughout the world on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday. This year Divine Mercy Sunday is April 7^h.

Let us not hesitate to receive the grace Our Lord wants to offer us on this Octave Day of Easter—for the glory of His name and our own eternal happiness!

**The extraordinary blessing of Divine Mercy Sunday requires you to receive Communion on the day of the Feast in a state of grace hence the requirement to have gone to Confession sometime before or on the Feast. <u>If you are in the state of very serious or mortal sin</u>, you must always confess it before receiving Jesus in Holy Communion, or you will commit a sacrilege, which is also a very serious sin. If you haven't been going to Sunday Mass without any

good reason, you may be in a state of serious sin, and you must confess before receiving Jesus in the Holy Communion.
