No second collection for SFA next week!! The remainder of the capital campaign has been paid! Thank you to the parishioners who paid the balance this week and all those who gave throughout.



CURRENT AND FUTURE CAPITAL CAMPAIGNS

As you know, parishes in our diocese have been asked to develop a study of our facilities and formation opportunities, with the intent of preparing for the next 20-30 years. We have had several parish meetings, in addition to our regular council meetings, and yet the work is ongoing due to its complexity. Our efforts have been focused on facilities and concerns over decreasing population brought to light in our preliminary findings.

Unfortunately, our weekly budget numbers don't reveal the complete picture. The budget does not include saving for long-range needs. It has taken more than two years to raise \$90,000. The current estimate required to maintain our current three campuses is an additional \$130,000 per year. Is it realistic to expect that we can raise this additional money annually? Please attend our parish meeting Dec. 15 at 6:15pm in St. Anselm Hall. After a presentation, active parishioners will be polled to make recommendations.
