## March 29, 2026: Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

"As they were marching out, they came upon a man of Cyrene, Simon by name; this man they pressed into service to carry his cross." MATTHEW 27:32

The Lord calls us to love God and to love our neighbor. Every day we are presented with opportunities to love our neighbor and help him "carry his cross." These opportunities aren't usually big events, they are usually ordinary occurrences like helping someone carry their groceries or holding the door open for them. The key is putting the other person's needs before our own and not expecting anything in return.

You may be among the majority of Catholics who miss out on the greatest events of the whole Church Year. **This Holy Week** do not be satisfied with just Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion Mass and an Easter Sunday morning Mass. Instead, plan to be present for each of these unique and inspiring services:

- \* **The Holy Thursday Evening--Mass of the Lord's Supper**
- \* **The Good Friday Afternoon--Celebration of the Lord's Passion**
- \* **The Holy Saturday Night--Easter Vigil**

Your personal prayers at home are not enough. If you can, you should be a part of a devout praying community. Once people have given these three services a priority in their lives, they eagerly come back to them year after year. We promise this: your faith in God, your hope in the resurrection, and your love for other saved sinners will probably never be stronger than on Saturday night after the Easter Vigil if you have prayerfully participated in all three of these great events.
